ASSISTANT COACHES

SAM DEL VESCOVO, ASSISTANT COACH

Sam Del Vescovo joined the Lake Forest coaching staff in 2023. 11 players on the team reached double figures in points in Del Vescovo's first season with the program and a league record 23 Foresters were named to the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association All-Academic Team. Prior to coming to Lake Forest, Vescovo coached at Marquette University for two years, serving as head coach of the ACHA D3 team and as an assistant with the ACHA D2 program. He was involved with every aspect of the program. Del Vescovo was also an assistant coach for the Milwaukee Power Hockey Team in 2020-21 running the defense and leading the staff's recruiting and scouting efforts. A 2020 graduate of Indiana Institute of Technology, Del Vescovo went on to earn a master's degree in sports and recreation business from Cardinal Stritch University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in 2022. In addition to coaching, Del Vescovo serves as an athletic facilities assistant at the College.

MARTY HOGAN, ASSISTANT COACH

Marty enters his 1st season on the Forester coaching staff. Marty grew up in Windsor, Ontario where he played AAA and Junior hockey. Marty has been a scout in the OHL for fifteen seasons, currently with the Ottawa 67's, and works on the coaching staff with the Republic of Estonia at their IIHF events. He has coached his oldest two in minor mites the last two seasons and looks forward to getting their youngest on the ice soon.

TONY MARTINO, GOALTENDING COACH

Tony Martino, a coach at numerous levels since 1999, joined the Lake Forest staff prior to the 2014-15 season as an assistant coach. He works directly with the team's goaltenders.

Martino has held several different positions in the sport of hockey and is currently an amateur scout for the NHL's Toronto Maple Leafs and Hockey Director at the Winter Club of Lake Forest.

Martino's head coaching experience began with three years with the New Mexico Scorpions of the CHL and a season with the Knoxville Ice Bears of the ACHL. He also directed two teams for a total of three years in Italy, where he claimed a Coppa de Presidente championship, and was the head coach and director of hockey operations of the Tulsa Oilers of the CHL.

In addition, Martino has been an assistant coach, goaltenders coach, video coach, or scout for several other organizations, including the Chicago Blackhawks. His most recent position was the goaltenders coach for the Lake Forest High School varsity team from 2010-13. He was also an assistant coach with the Chicago Express of the ECHL in 2011-12.

PREVIOUS STOPS

2011-13 SUNY Potsdam Assistant Coach

Bio: The 2024-25 season will be Sean O'Malley's fourth as head coach of the Foresters and 11th with the program.

O'Malley has helped lead Lake Forest to an 112-112-22 overall record and a 82-80-14 mark in NCHA play over the last 10 seasons. At 18-6-3, the 2019-20 Foresters posted the program's best overall record since 1991 and their 14-4-2 mark in the NCHA is a school record. That team also qualified for the NCAA Division III Tournament for the first time in nearly three decades.

Nine Foresters have been named all-conference, including a pair of NCHA Players of the Year and three First Team West All-American selections, since O'Malley joined the staff. In addition, Lake Forest has had a player named to the NCHA All-Freshman Team in five of the last eight seasons.

Lake Forest has broken or tied 15 program records in the last nine years, including a 15-game unbeaten streak that was the longest in the nation during the 2014-15 season.

The Foresters have also been extremely successful in the classroom, earning 158 NCHA All-Academic Team accolades during that time, including a league record 23 in 2023-24.

O'Malley came to Lake Forest from the State University of New York at Potsdam, where he served for two seasons as an assistant coach, recruiting coordinator, and academic advisor.

For seven years O'Malley was an on-ice instructor at Can/Am Hockey Schools in Lake Placid, New York, and Guelph, Ontario. He spent last summer in Cleveland as an on-ice instructor for the Ohio Hockey Project, where he coached Junior A players. O'Malley has also served as an evaluator with USA Hockey Development.

O'Malley, a 2010 graduate of the College at Brockport, was a four-year member of the Golden Eagles men's ice hockey team. As a senior he served as an assistant captain and was the recipient of the Bob Pedersen Coach's Award, exemplifying character and work ethic as a student-athlete. After graduating with a degree in criminal justice, O'Malley pursued a professional career with the Wheeling Nailers of the East Coast Hockey League as well as various minor league teams.

A native of Cleveland, Ohio, O'Malley played golf and hockey at St. Ignatius High School, and is a member of the St. Ignatius Hockey Hall of Fame. He also played as a post graduate for Gilmour Academy and the Syracuse Stars of the EJHL.

SCOUTING THE RAIDERS

- MSOE secured a point in the conference standings taking the #3 ranked Aurora Spartans to a shootout last Friday.
- The Raiders have played some of their better hockey as of late posting a record of 2-1-2 over their last 5 contests. During this stretch MSOE has collected both their wins by 4-2 scores including a victory over #6 St. Norbert. Their only defeat during this span occurred last Saturday falling 6-3 to Aurora.
- Offensively MSOE is led by junior forward Carson Jones with 22 points 7g/15a through 22 games. Jones ranks ninth in the conference in assists (15) and T-11th in points (22). Rookie forward Eddie Shepler is second on the team in points with 17 points 11g/6a and his 11 goals are 8th best in the NCHA faceoff while veteran forward Seth Bernanrd does not trail far behind with 16 points 7g/9a.
- On the backend, junior Cole Beilke and sophomore Adam Smith pace the Raiders defense with 9 points each. Beilke notched his 9th point of the season last game against Aurora collecting his 4th goal of the season and Smith ranks 4th on the team in assists (8). Senior captain Ryan Reid leads the group in blocks with 20 followed by Adam Smith (17) and Nikolai Charchenko (16).
- In goal, junior Austin Schwab has started 20 of a possible 23 games for MSOE carrying a record of 8-8-3 and is responsible for a goals against average of 2.54 and a .906 save percentage. Schwab's 2.54 GAA is 3rd best in the conference and has also recorded 2 shutouts this season (Suffolk/Tufts). In 4 starts against Lake Forest the Washington native owns a 3-0-0 record, 2.68 GAA, and a .930 SV% with 2 shutouts.
- The Raiders are 3rd best in faceoffs (52.9%) 4th in scoring defense (2.57) in the NCHA and average the 5th most shots per game (27.78). On special teams MSOE is 8th in the conference on the PP (14.4%) and rank 5th on the PK (82.7%).

AROUND THE NCHA

- This weekend #3 Aurora will host Dubuque after taking 5 of a possible 6 points last weekend against MSOE. Dubuque dropped their contests to Lawrence last weekend falling 4-2 and 2-1. #6 St. Norbert will battle Lawrence in a home and home series after collecting 5 of 6 NCHA points on the road last weekend against Lake Forest. #7 Trine will meet with #12 Adrian in a home and home series after splitting with Marian last weekend in a pair of games decided by one goal. The Bulldogs took care of business against CUW outscoring the Falcons 14-1 in the weekend series. To round out the final weekend of the regular season the Marian Sabres will face CUW in a home and home series.

LAST WEEKEND RECAP

- Lake Forest dropped a pair of heart breakers to #6 ranked St. Norbert dropping by games by 3-2 scores. The Green Knights played spoiler against the Foresters completing the comeback in both games. On Friday, St. Norbert battled back multiple times and ultimately netted the game-winning goal 37 seconds into the 3rd period. On Saturday, Lake Forest built a 2-0 lead and once again the visitors responded with a pair of goals in the 3rd period tying the game with 9.1 seconds remaining. St. Norbert converted in OT to complete the comeback.

PETER TAYLOR AWARD

- Senior captain Jared Gerger was named the 2025 Peter Taylor award winner last Saturday on Alumni Day. Gerger became the 31st recipient of the award after it was established during the 1993-94 season. The award was established as a fond tribute by Peter's family, friends and former teammates. It is awarded annually to the player, selected by his teammates, whose outstanding talent, leadership and love for the game best exemplify the qualities of the player for whom it is named - Peter G. Taylor.

A DOZEN DELIGHTS

- Rookie forward Trevor Faucher has been electric to begin his collegiate career leading the team in goals (10). Faucher ranks 2nd on the team in points (17) through 21 games and T-2nd in +/- (7). His 10 goals rank 3rd amongst rookies in the NCHA and his 17 points are 4th best in the conference for rookie skaters.

ROSS THE BOSS

- The Calgarian matched a career high in goals (9) tying his total from his rookie season thanks to a pair of goals last weekend against St. Norbert. His 9 goals this season are 2nd most on the team and ranks 3rd on the team in points (16). His 16 points in 19 games are good for a .84 point/game pace which is top 20 in the NCHA.

NOTES

SENIOR NIGHT

• Tonight the Foresters will honor their 13 seniors on senior night. The class of 2025 is represented by 2 goaltenders, 5 defenseman, and 6 forwards. Combined this year's class has a winning percentage of .365 over 100 total games and has made 2 postseason appearances. This season, the group of 13 has contributed for 19 goals, 56 assists, and 75 points which accounts for nearly 40% of the team's scoring.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

• The Forester men's hockey program takes great pride in the success of their student-athletes in the classroom. During the fall semester, the team earned a GPA of 3.73 with 9 different players accumulating a perfect 4.0 GPA.

• Last season, the Foresters set a new standard totaling 23 players earning NCHA All-Academic team honors. With 23 players on the list, the Forester men surpassed the conference record they originally set in 2021 and tied last season. That represents nearly 77 percent of the 30 players who were on the roster.

• In addition, Lake Forest had 12 players recognized as Chi-Alfa Sigma inductees last spring to further celebrate the academic success of junior academic standing or higher after their fifth full time semester, and earn a 3.4 or higher cumulative grade point average.

• College Sports Communicators (CSC) announced the 2023-24 Academic All-District® At-Large Teams on Tuesday and six Forester men's hockey players were listed. To be eligible for nomination, student-athletes maintain at least a 3.50 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale at their current institution and be at least a sophomore academically and athletically. Hockey players also must compete in at least 90 percent of their team's games. The 6 players honors included Griffen Sanom, Jared Gerger, Tyler Buonopane, Ben Perkins, Chase Freiermuth, and Connor Sullivan.

LEADERSHIP GROUP

• Lake Forest retained the majority of their leadership group from a season ago returning all their captains except Ben Perkins who graduated last spring. Senior defenders Matteas Derraugh and Connor Sullivan will both serve as alternate captains and will be joined by junior forward Justin Ross. After doing the 'A' last season Jared Gerger will wear the 'C' this season alongside senior defenseman Ryan Antonakis who transferred to Lake Forest his sophomore season and will wear a letter for the first time in his collegiate career.

• Head Coach Sean O'Malley described this season's leadership group as "a group that is highly looked up to and bring a wealth of experience to the rest of our team. These individuals are the heartbeat of our team and continue to raise the compete level of those around them. I am excited to watch them lead our team and they all help set the standard of excellence we expect to be met and most importantly are great role models and everything you would want in a leadership group."

WELCOME TO THE FOREST

• The Foresters will welcome 7 newcomers to the Forest for the 2024-25 season. The class of 2028 is composed of 2 defenseman and 5 forwards.

#7 Johnathon Mead - the Campbellville, ON native comes to the Forest after spending parts of 4 seasons in the OJHL amassing 137 games recording 34g/72a.

#12 Trevor Faucher - the Spanish Fort, AL centerman spent the previous 2 seasons in the CCHL with the Smiths Falls Bears appearing in 102 games notching 39g/56a. In 33 postseason games he tallied 20 points (6g/14a)

#18 Teddy Puccini - the Burlington, ON forward spent parts of 3 seasons in the OJHL with the Georgetown Raiders. In 96 career OJHL games Puccini tallied 36g/45a for 81 points along with 4 assists in 10 postseason games.

#19 Jonah Copre - the Elgin, IL defenseman completed his junior hockey journey in the NCDL with the Jersey Rockets after a stint in the USHL with Waterloo and NAHL with Shreveport. Last season as the captain of the Jersey Rockets, Copre led the league in assists by a defenseman (41) and points (49).

#21 Max Abramson - the Pacific Palisades, CA forward spent the last 2 seasons with the Northern Cyclones (USPHL) helping the Cyclones secured the championship during the 2022-23 season. In 79 career USPHL games Abramson collected 33g/40a for 73 points earning him a promotion to the NCDL team at the end of last season netting a goal in 3 games.

#22 Hunter Cooke - the Highlands Ranch, CO defenseman won an EHL championship with the Boston Jr. Rangers before completing his junior career with the Colorado Grit last season playing 53 games and recorded 104 PIM's.

#29 Jax Schauer - the Hastings, MN forward spent the bulk of last season with the Mason City Toros (NA3HL) producing 47 points (26g/21a) in 40 games earning him NA3HL All-Divisional Team (West) honors. Schauer also has 46 games of NAHL experience registering 4 points (2g/2a).

NOTES

HOME SWEET HOME

- The Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse, designed by Naess & Murphy, was dedicated at a basketball game on December 6, 1950. It was the home site of Forester basketball games (the floor was installed manually), a training and instruction area for all sports, a rental for dog, horse, car, and model train shows, and often the site for the College's annual commencement ceremony.
- Following construction of the Sports Center in 1968, Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse was converted into a permanent home for Forester hockey. The new \$300,000 rink was installed in the Fieldhouse and represented the culmination of long-range dreams and plans by Athletic Director Nick Wasyluk and Coach Lufay Anderson Sweet II. Arthur Nickolas, a well-respected architect specializing in ice arenas who had worked with several professional hockey teams, was contacted to design and construct the rink. The most up-to-date techniques in rink design were employed by Nickolas to give Lake Forest a facility that rivaled any other indoor arena in the nation.
- On January 9, 1970 the Lake Forest College hockey team, which had previously played outdoors at the nearby Winter Club, skated onto the ice in its new home inside the Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse against visiting Oberlin College.
- The College embarked on the Home Ice Advantage Campaign in 2008 to renovate and modernize the hockey facilities at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse. The first phase which was completed in 2015, included new boards, glass, and scoreboards and a significantly revamped look to the varsity locker rooms, grandstand, lobby, and coaches' suite. The second phase of renovation featured the replacement of the refrigeration system and concrete flooring, installation of a dehumidifier, and updated lighting. In total, the two phase fundraising initiative encompassed \$4.5 million in gifts.

NAHL FACTORY

- The Foresters continue to tap into familiar pipelines adding 3 newcomers with NAHL junior hockey experience. Defensemen Hunter Cooke and Jonah Copre both had stints in the North American Hockey League prior to coming to the Forest. Cooke, completed his junior career with the Colorado Grit while Copre spent parts of 2 seasons in the league making stops in Shreveport and . Forward Jax Schauer played 46 career games in the NAHL seeing action with the Iowa Bulls. Overall, Lake Forest has 17 different players with NAHL experience.

NORTH OF THE BORDER

- Lake Forest continues to find talent north of the border with 7 different players hailing from Canada. The 7 Canadian's include two goaltenders, four forwards, and one defenseman. In total, Lake Forest has 10 different players on the roster with Canadian junior hockey experience. In fact, 3 members of this season's recruiting class played their junior hockey in Canadian junior leagues (Johnathon Mead, Teddy Puccini, Trevor Faucher). The previous 3 captains of the team are Canadian and both of this season's captains spent parts of their junior career in Canada.

REUNITED IN THE FOREST

- The Foresters have many established connections on this season's roster playing together prior to coming to the Forest.
- Junior Colin Bella skated with seniors Tyler Buonopane and Connor Sullivan at the junior level with the Connecticut Roughriders (EHL).
- Goaltender Alex Rohlf was teammates with defensemen Connor Sullivan at the prep level during the 2019-20 season at Brunswick along and briefly played with junior forward Andrew Kimball in the EHL with the Seahawks Hockey Club during the 2021-22 season. Kimball also played prep hockey with defenseman Fabrizio Mazzarelli at the Millbrook School (2019-20).
- Senior forwards Griffen Sanom and Donny Borgula played youth hockey together in Michigan during their U14 season (2013-14) with Victory Honda and U18 (2017-18) with Compuware prior to their arrivals in the Forest.
- Rookie forward Trevor Faucher was teammates alongside sophomore defender Jared Kaplowitz with the Nashville Jr. Predators 18AAA team (2020-21).
- Sophomore Hayden Riva and Jared Kaplowitz were teammates together briefly during the 2021-22 season with the Springfield Jr. Blues (NAHL).
- The Northern Cyclones has also produced a number of Foresters including current defenseman Seth Orozco and Andrew Nieuwsma who played there together during the 2021-22 season and the following season Orozco won the league championship with rookie forward Max Abramson.
- Chase Freiermuth and Jax Schauer both played high school hockey together in Minnesota at Hastings (2019-20).



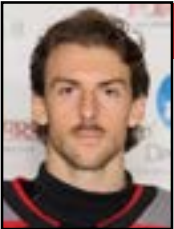
